



Introduction

Port of Adria is a member of Global Ports Holding (GPH), a unique port group and operator of cruise and commercial ports with the established in the Caribbean, Mediterranean, Asia-Pacific regions, including extensive commercial port operations in Turkey and Montenegro.

GPH currently controls a portfolio of 16 leading cruise and commercial ports in ten different countries: in Turkey – Port Akdeniz, Antalya, Ege Ports, Kusadası and Bodrum Cruise Port; in Montenegro – Port of Adria, Bar; in Portugal – Lisbon Cruise Terminals; in Spain – Creuers Barcelona – Barcelona Cruise Port and Cruceros Malaga – Malaga Cruise Port; in Singapore – Marina Bay Cruise Center Singapore; in Malta – Valleta Cruise Port; in Croatia – Zadar Cruise Port; in Italy – Venice Cruise Port, Ravenna Cruise Port, Cagliari Cruise Port, Catania Cruise Port, in Cuba – La Habana Cruise Port and in Bahamas – Nassau Cruise Port.

Port of Adria represents an important link in the intermodal transport chain in the region due to its integration with Bar-Belgrade railways and road transport network and an opportunity for establishing distribution centres for a range of product groups. Complete area of Port of Adria is under Free Zone regime and provides benefits in terms of exemption from customs duties, taxes and other duties.




Port of Adria overview

Port of Adria has an operational quay of 1.440 meters long.

There is a possibility to berth various types of ships on all nine berths at the same time as per international practices.

Container Terminal and Services

Terminal is equipped for unloading, handling and loading containers, stuffing and stripping of containers. All the activities are carried out both on open storages and in warehouses, depending on the goods and required handling methods.

Key features:

- Operational quay length of 1,5 km
- 2 STSG container cranes
- Maximum permissible draft 11,5 m
- 270 Reefer plugs
- Railway tracks reach every berth and warehouse



Bar Cruise Port

First cruise ship arrived in 2014 and designated the beginning of development Bar as cruising destination on the Adriatic Sea. Season 2016 was characterized by arrival of 7 ships of the British company Thomson Cruises, when the city Bar was marked on the map of the leading international cruise companies.

With the acceptance of new ships through different companies, Bar presented itself to new markets.
